Young Leaders Award Qualifications

- A CoreNet Global Chicago Chapter member in good standing
- Under the age of 35; person submitting the nomination should make this verification
- Must be within or serve the corporate real estate community
- Cannot be on the Awards committee for the REAL Awards or CoreNet Global Chicago Chapter Board Member
- Must work and reside in the Greater Chicago Area or Central Midwest
- Has demonstrated promise as a future leader in CoreNet Global and the Chicago Real Estate Community

Nominator will need to provide:

- Bio (pdf)
- Headshot (image)
- 1 Letter of Recommendation or Commendation from Industry Peers

Young Leader Awards Criteria:

- Describe how this person has demonstrated leadership within their job or volunteer activities.
- Please share why you are nominating this person.
- Describe how this nominee has positively impacted their company and/or the real estate profession.
 - *The nominee demonstrated best practices and implemented initiatives that positively impacted the profession.*
 - *The nominee demonstrated quantifiable achievements that contributed to their employer's success*
- Describe the type of involvement this person has had with the CoreNet Global Chicago Chapter
- List key achievements in leadership, both professional and civic

If not self-nominating, the nominator needs to collaborate with the nominee on content for the award as well as gain permission from the nominee to be nominated.

Corporate Real Estate (CRE) Executive of the Year

This category recognizes the Corporate Real Estate (CRE) executive who made outstanding and distinguished contribution to his/her company and to the industry.

Corporate Real Estate Executive of the Year Award Qualifications

- A CoreNet Global Chicago Chapter member in good standing for past 2 ½ years
- End User (occupier) must be in CRE for past 2 ½ years
- Cannot be on the Awards committee for the REAL Awards or a Board member for the CoreNet Global Chicago Chapter
- Must work and reside in the Greater Chicago area or Central Midwest
- Demonstrated contribution to their organization's success
- Demonstrated commitment to the CRE industry as educator or leader
- Led innovative corporate real estate projects**
- Demonstrated a partnership with other internal key support functions, such as HR & IT
- Demonstrated best practices and initiatives that resulted in more efficient processes and cost reduction for the company

***Innovation is defined as an activity or initiative that brings about a paradigm shift in the way that business is done in a rapidly changing economy.*

Nominator will need to provide:

- Bio (pdf)
- Headshot (image)
- 1 Letter of Recommendation or Commendation from Industry Peers

Corporate Real Estate Executive of the Year Award Criteria:

- Describe how this person has demonstrated leadership within the industry.
- Describe how this individual has elevated the CRE function within their organization to include partnering with other key functions (i.e. HR, IT).
 - *The nominee demonstrated a diverse set of skills that helped the CRE function gain status as an equal partner in a collaborative role either with key support functions in the company, e.g., HR and IT and/or business groups within the enterprise*
- Cite examples of collaborative and innovative solutions
- Describe what practices or initiatives resulted in cost or process improvements including any supporting metrics.
- Provide relevant examples of this person's involvement in CoreNet Global Chicago Chapter.
 - *Actively engaged member (examples of engagement: Chapter leader, attended a Summit; earned MCR or SLCR designation, speaker at a CoreNet Global event, contributed to the content of a Chapter program/event; participated in Chapter special programs, provided content for Leader magazine, participated in a research project, etc.)*

If not self-nominating, the nominator needs to collaborate with the nominee on content for the award as well as gain permission from the nominee to be nominated.

- Must work and reside in the Greater Chicago Area or Central Midwest
- Demonstrated contribution to their organization's success
- Demonstrated commitment to the real estate industry
- Provides excellent value to clients and exceeding expectations
- Applies innovative ideas & approaches to problem-solving

Nominator will need to provide:

- Bio (pdf)
- Headshot (image)
- Client Testimonial (1 page)

Service Provider of the Year Criteria:

- Cite an example of a project or client engagement where delivery expectations were exceeded.
- Cite an example or project where excellent value was delivered to the client. Include pertinent metrics i.e. cost reduction, process improvement.
- Describe the innovative idea(s) or creative problem solving demonstrated by this person.
- Describe how this person has demonstrated leadership and commitment to the real estate industry.
- Describe the type of involvement this person has had with the CoreNet Global Chicago Chapter.

Sustainable Leadership Award

CoreNet Global's Sustainable Leadership Award celebrates work that accelerates the adoption of environmentally friendly and socially responsible real estate practices.

Sustainable Leadership Awards Qualifications

Demonstrated connection of project, process or program to environmental sustainability. Breadth of impact and type of impact of project, process or program on a firm's employees and/or clients and the environment. Project must have been completed between July 1, 2015 and July 1, 2016. If an innovative process or a program, the process or program must have been put in place formally between July 1, 2015 and July 1, 2016.

Cannot be on the Awards committee for the REAL Awards.

If not self-nominating, the nominator needs to collaborate with the nominee on content for the award as well as gain permission from the nominee to be nominated.

Nominator should provide (if applicable):

- Project location (city, state, country)
- Date of completion
- Budget (final) hard costs (actual construction costs). Fee need not be included.
- Metrics, i.e., carbon foot print affected
- Type of project (e.g. office, hospital, library, etc)
- Client (company/project authority)
- Design firm (Project manager/design team manager)
- Contact name, phone number and email
- Photos (jpg format; 72 dpi)
- Video submissions are encouraged but not required. In addition to submitting still photography, short DVDs no longer than 2 minutes will also be accepted of workplace tours and client testimonials only as it relates and supports awards criteria

Provide a one sentence tagline for the project and a 100-word or less description of the project

Project of the Year Award

- Completed between July 1, 2015 and July 1, 2016
- Member or Sponsor in good standing
- Nominee must work/reside in the Chicagoland area; the proposed project can be located worldwide
- Cannot be on the Awards committee for the REAL Awards

***Innovation is defined as an activity or initiative that brings about a paradigm shift in the way that business is done in a rapidly changing economy.*

Project of the Year Award Criteria:

- Description of project (including size), summary of innovation, complexity of project, applicable project metrics
- How the team worked together / collaborated to make it a successful project
- Applicability to other organizations, i.e., the concept has advanced the field of design, engineering, or real estate utilization

Provide a one sentence tagline for the project and a 100-word or less description of the project.

If not self-nominating, the nominator needs to collaborate with the nominee on content for the award as well as gain permission from the nominee to be nominated.
